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A Precautions For Safe Handling


#### Please observe the following precautions.


- · Opening lock knob with a long nail or an artificial nail may cause a chipping or breaking nail.
- · Do not set up housing in a dusty or sandy environment.
- Handle housing carefully to prevent any strong impacts by dropping or crashing.
- · Do not leave or keep housing in a place being exposed to direct sunlight or high temperature like on the sand, on the deck of a boat or in the trank of a car, etc.
- After rinsing housing in fresh water to remove salts, dry with a towel, do not use any kinds of heating equipment.
- Do not use the petroleum solvents such as alcohol, benzin and thinner, or oil/chemicals allied products such as corrosion prevention, lubricant and glazing agents.
- · Do not leave or keep housing at any place in high humidity or extreme fluctuations in temperature.
- · Keep the housing out of children's reach.

## ▲ Maintenance/ Storage

- · Rinse the housing thoroughly in fresh water after use and keep in a cool and dry place, away from direct sunlight.
- Do not keep housing in a place with extreme fluctuations in temperature, extreme cold, or high humidity.
- We recommend a complete overhaul of housing per year.



## A. Camera Settings (IMPORTANT)

- 1. Remove the eyepiece cup and hot shoe cap from camera body. All the accessories need to be removed; such as strap, etc.
- 2. Press the MENU button.

Select **2** tab.

Then, enter into FINDER/MONITOR menu.

3. Select Monitor(Manual) in the FINDER/MONITOR menu.

## **B. Manual Display Switch Settings**

**%**After finish the setting at section A, you could not use the viewfinder. However, you can assign the custom key for switch between viewfinder and LCD screen manually. Here we will assign C4 button.

1. Press the **MENU** button.

Select **2** tab. Then, enter into Custom Key

2. Select Custom Button 4. Then, change the option to Finder/Monitor Sel.

> The setting is completed. You can switch the display between finder and monitor by using C4 button.

- 2. Slightly turn up the screen. The protruding part is facing the front of the camera, please be careful of the wrong direction.

## **D. After-diving Maintenance**

1. Wash the seawater with clean water, and dry it with a towel.





- 5. To open the latch, you can simply push the latch button at **1**, then pull the latch lever at 2.
- 6. Remove the top hook and open the back casing of the housing.
- 7. Put it in a clean place without dust, hair, etc.
- 8. Clean the flat part of the outside of the O-ring groove (about 5mm).



- 3. Wipe it with a paper towel or cotton swab.

## **E.** Port Installation

UU-A7RIII UW housing is using bayonet mount port. When the camera is installed in the housing, the port is locked by the camera tray for prevent the port remove and rotate by accident.

Please ensure the camera tray is remove from the housing before install the port.

- 1. Align  $\bigcirc$  mark on the housing and the port, and press the port straight down.
- 2. Turn the port clockwise until the () mark is aligned to the O mark on the housing.
